

Great Britain U19 Team is looking to appoint Video & Performance Analysis Coaches

The candidates will assist in providing high quality analysis to the U19 teams and must be able to demonstrate a commitment and passion to the development of players. The chosen applicants will gain valuable experience in a national elite performance environment, and will have the opportunity to apply their current knowledge within an applied setting.

The role is ideal for Coaches who wish to have an important role and impact on the National programme, but may have commitment limitations to attend physical training sessions or games but can commit to undertaking the role at home.

Main duties and areas of development include:

- Filming* and break down of training for the use of individual, positional and team feedback to both players and coaches
- Game Day Assistance for Teams (filming)
- Recruitment Analysis
- Scout Film (Opponents) breakdown and analysis
- Individual projects that will benefit both individually and the programme.
- Managing the online platform analysis tool.

DETAILS OF DUTIES:

- Design and deliver analysis processes and protocols to gather and disseminate pertinent information on agreed KPI's and Game Plan requirements in both training and matches, as agreed with the Coaching Team.
- Monitor technical and tactical KPI's for both players and teams throughout the season and regularly liaise with coaches to feedback objective information and insight.
- Design and monitor databases (local and online) to store and interrogate performance data in order improve understanding of the key data for success, development and performance
- Work closely with Positional Coaches, Coordinators and the Head Coach to deliver an analysis strategy that meets the needs of all key stakeholders in understanding and maximizing performance on the field.

- Keep abreast of the latest relevant technological advances, and where suitable utilize new technologies to gain a competitive advantage.
- When appropriate have the communication skills to constructively challenge and support coaches.

- Be studying for a Performance Analysis, Sports Science or related degree or have relevant experience either coaching and/or using video analysis software like Hudl
- Practical and relevant experience within performance analysis and a strong understanding of the workings of American
- Excellent understanding of the game of American football with at least 3 years experience of working in an American football environment.
- Demonstrable experience of impacting on performance through analysis processes / protocols.
- Highly numerate with strong technical and computer skills.
- Ability to explain statistical issues to diverse audiences of varying expertise, through the intelligent use of graphics and visualisations.
- Demonstrable database and statistical analysis skills.
- Experience of report writing and design – translating analysis into literate, concise documentation.
- Excellent written and spoken English.
